






- Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) and Acute Kidney Injury (AKI): well-defined and detectable
- Some patients have Acute Kidney Disease (AKD) without AKI and are considered normal
- What is the risk of CKD in patients with AKD w/o AKI?









- AKD w/o AKI = subset of "normal" patients at \uparrow risk of CKD, ESRD, and/or death who fall under the radar
- Who best to identify and manage these patients: PCP or nephrologist? How to treat?
